SUMMARY

24 Budokan athletes competed in 30 divisions at the 2019 ACT International Open winning 18 medals (53% of athletes; 60% of divisions):

8 x Gold, 4 x Silver, 6 x Bronze medals + 3 x 5th, 2 x 7th placings

By comparison in 2018 25 athletes competed in 35 divisions winning 19 medals:

7 Gold, 3 Silver, 9 Bronze, 13 x 5th/7th placings, and

in 2017, 32 athletes competed in 44 divisions winning: 19 medals:

7 Gold, 5 Silver, 7 Bronze, 14 x 5th/7th/9th
