In addition 2 Bernhard and Bianca competed in Junior Nage-No-Kata winning Gold

By comparison, in 2018,
15 Budokan athletes competed in 20 divisions winning 15 medals (75% of divisions):
7 x Gold, 1 x Silver, 7 x Bronze medals + 2 x 5th placings

and in 2017,
27 Budokan athletes competed in 41 divisions winning 26 medals (63% of divisions):
9 x Gold, 4 x Silver, 13 x Bronze medals + 6 x 5th placings
