



2021 BUDOKAN MONStEr & JUNIOR TOURNAMENT – Sunday 14th March 2021

Pre-Entry: Please log in and register on-line via the Judo NSW website by midnight Thursday 11th March. Please take care to enter the correct Age Category (either "Mons" or "Juniors") and the correct Grade Category (either "Novice" or "Graded"). Please ensure that during the process of selecting the "Age" and "Grade" options from the dropdown menus, that you select "not applicable" for all other available options that do not apply.

Entering on the day: To manage venue entry restrictions, entry for the competition on the day will **NOT BE** accepted. No exceptions.

Weight divisions: Will be determined on the day to maximise division sizes. During the on-line entry, please nominate the closest weight division although these may not necessarily apply on the day.

Format: We are running the MONS and JUNIOR divisions separately. Weigh-in for Juniors will commence after the MONS presentations have been made. Mats will be sanitized between the Mons and Juniors competitions.

Entry Fee: \$25.00 per player. Spectators Free

MONS - Weigh-in – 9am - 9:30am

Eligibility: Must turn 6, 7 or 8 in 2021 i.e. born in 2013, 2014, and 2015

NOVICE Belt colours: White Yellow, White Yellow with Black Tip

GRADED Belt colours: Yellow belt and higher

Indicative Weight divisions (weight divisions will be determined after weigh-ins):

Girls/Boys – U21, U24, U27, U31, U35, U40, U45, O45kg

JUNIOR BOYS/GIRLS - Weigh-in – 12.30pm – 1.00pm

Eligibility: Must turn 9, 10 or 11 in 2021 i.e. born in 2010, 2011 and 2012

NOVICE Belt colours: White Yellow, White Yellow with Black Tip, Yellow, Yellow with Black Tip, Yellow Orange, Yellow Orange with Black Tip

GRADED Belt colours: Orange belt and higher

Indicative Weight divisions (weight divisions will be determined after weigh-ins):

Girls – U25, U29, U32, U36, U40, U44, U48, U52, O52kg

Boys – U24, U27, U30, U34, U38, U42, U46, U50, O50kg

ALL ATHLETES MUST HAVE A WHITE JUDO GI

At this time, venue number restrictions apply. i.e. 4sqm off the mat, so we have a restricted number of spectators permitted in the hall at any time, including coaches.

Therefore, please allow parents of athletes competing to take priority in the venue. Please also respect social distancing outside the venue, especially around the doorways.
